

Your Quick Guide to Healthcare Services in Qatar

Welcome to Qatar! The Ministry of Public Health wishes you a safe and healthy FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022!

Visitors coming to Qatar for the tournament can access medical care at any of the country's private or public hospitals, medical centers, clinics and pharmacies.

Medical Emergencies

In the event of a medical emergency you can request an ambulance by calling **999**.

Our operators will immediately dispatch an ambulance as well as provide life-saving pre-arrival instruction over the line, where required. The service operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

For non-life-threatening conditions

Healthcare teams are on-hand if you require urgent medical assistance at the stadiums, official fan zones and festivals, and fan accommodation.

Multiple clinics are located at all 8 stadiums with healthcare teams on-hand on match days.

- 1. Clinics are located at the following public fan zones and festivals during the designated opening hours of each venue:
 - FIFA Fan Festival
 - Corniche
 - Al Khor Fan Zone
 - Industrial Area Fan Zone
- 2. Clinics operating 24 hours a day, 7 days a week are located at the following Fan Accommodation sites:
 - Barwa Madinatna Fan Village
 - Barahat Al Janoub Fan Village
 - Doha Port Grand Terminal allocated to the Cruise Ship Floating Hotels





At a healthcare facility

Urgent care units located conveniently around Qatar provide 24-hour walk-in care for patients with non-threatening medical needs, such as minor burns, sprains, severe headache or earache, high fever, dehydration and dizziness.

You can visit one of the following:

- 1. A private hospital or medical clinic visit the MOPH website to see all private hospitals with emergency and urgent services open 24/7
- 2. An Urgent Care Unit at one of the following Hamad Medical Corporation hospitals
 - Aisha bint Hamad Al Attiyah Hospital
 - Al Wakra Hospital
 - Hamad General Hospital
 - Hazm Mebaireek General Hospital

Visiting fans can access emergency and urgent medical services at HMC facilities free of charge throughout the tournament. To receive these services free of charge, fans must present their Hayya Card to the healthcare facility.

COVID-19 Testing

The Ministry of Public Health has accredited more than 100 healthcare facilities to provide COVID-19 tests.

- PCR tests are provided by more than one hundred private hospitals and clinics in Qatar at a cost of QR160 per test.
- Rapid antigen tests are available at more than 100 private hospitals and clinics in Qatar at a cost of QR50 per test.
